- Students who will be applying to any state certified University or College

APPLICATION PACKET

1. **Application Form:** Fill out your form completely or mark N/A if not applicable. Incomplete information may affect the rating of your application. All information you provide is strictly confidential.
2. **Two current letters of recommendation** describing your qualifications that make you a clear choice for an AERF Scholarship.
3. **Academic transcript** (unofficial copy allowed) from your last two semesters, three quarters, or a copy of your most recent transcript.
4. **Essay** (250 words min.) on your career goals.
5. **Letter of Recommendation** by a PCA National member in good standing.

APPLICATION DEADLINE & NOTIFICATION

All application packets must be postmarked by December 7, 2019. The Trustees will make their decision in January 2020. Scholarship award recipients will be contacted via mail by February 14, 2020. All applicants will be mailed notice of their final status.

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

AERF will award up to \$1,500 in scholarship awards to students applying to University of College. Scholarship awards are for the 2020-2021 school year. Applicants may reapply for scholarship awards in subsequent years.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged according to the following criteria:

- **20% Academic Record**
- **20% Financial Need**
- **15% Community Service/
Extracurricular School Activities**
- **15% Recommendations**
- **15% Essay**
- **15% Work Experience**
